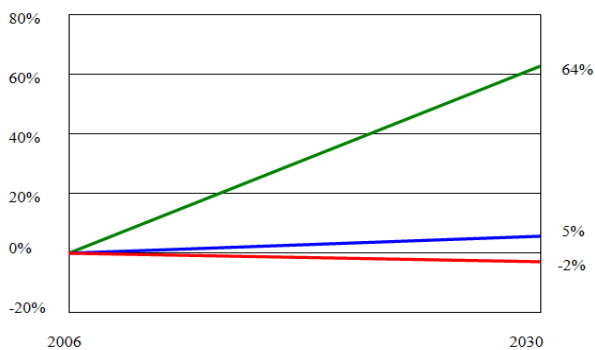
The Federal Stimulus Package: What's it Mean for CT's Aging Population?
