ITEM #1: Approval of May 2008 meeting minutes

→ Motion to approve the May 12, 2008 meeting minutes without alteration.

ITEM #2: Financial update

→ Dennis Rozum informed the Board money was transferred into repairs and maintenance, communications, gas, and transfer station overtime accounts from other accounts in order to last to the end of the fiscal year.

→ Rozum also recommended using Pye, Inc. for catch basin cleaning in the upcoming year as the company has quoted a price of \$35 per basin.

ITEM #3: New Mason Truck Quote/Review/Recommendation

→ Dennis Rozum informed the Board that he received bids from Interstate Ford on two vehicles: a Ford F-550 and a Sterling Bullet. After reviewing the quotes and accompanying sales literature, the Board recommended purchasing the Sterling Bullet because of its warranty and the praise the vehicle has received from other towns with the vehicle currently in operation.

ITEM #4: Equipment Update

→ Dennis Rozum informed the Board that at this time everything in the fleet is working. Routine maintenance will be performed soon on larger vehicles. Rozum is reviewing quotes to either

rebuild or replace a jackhammer that is not working properly and a cement mixer will be replaced if something suitable comes along. The street sweeper is doing well and, unless a problem arises, street sweeping has concluded for the time being.

ITEM #5: Other business

→ Robert Pagliaro inquired about the status of pothole repair and paving within the town. Dennis Rozum stated that work has been planned for Cozy Lane, Titus Lane, Kathy Drive, Davis Road, Spruce Street, and Carriage Drive.

→ Dennis Rozum stated that wooden guardrails on West Street would be repaired soon.

→ John Putorti stated that portions of Bungay Road need to be repaired. Rozum stated that repairs would be done soon to replace the temporary repairs that are currently in place.

→ John Leon asked about the status of the assistant director/ foreman's position. Members of the sub-committee in charge of interviewing potential candidates for the position responded by saying the process is moving forward, but is currently waiting for further directive from Town Hall.
