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Minutes of the Seymour WPCA special meeting for
January 6th, 2009 at 6:00 pm –at the Sewer Facility

Members Present: John Fanotto, Stephen Chucta, Lou DeBarber and Jon Livolsi

Members Not Present: Charles Bellavance.

Others present: Jon Marro, Jim Galligan, PE and other members of the public.

John Fanotto called the meeting to order at 6:08pm

Stephen Chucta made a motion, Jon Livolsi 2nd, to approve the December 2nd, 2008 minutes. Motion passed 3-0-1 abstention (Lou DeBarber).

Seymour Housing Authority; 30-32-34 Seymour Ave- represented by Don Smith, PE. Don Smith presented a plan for connected the three units onto sanitary sewer via a force main to a pump house that connects to the sewer main on Seymour Avenue. After some discussion on the technical details, the board assessed a fee of \$2,450 per unit, Mylar asbuilts upon completion, with a note on the asbuilts that the Seymour Housing Authority is responsible for the maintenance & upkeep of the sewer line and pump house on the property (up to the main line connection in the road). Motion was made by **Jon Livolsi**, 2nd by Stephen Chucta, motion passed 4-0.

60 Kathy Drive was moved up the agenda by the motion of **Jon Livolsi**, 2nd Lou DeBarber, and motion passed 4-0.

60 Kathy Drive- Mr. & Mrs. Meyer were represented by Atty. Stanek.

Atty. Bruchal (not present) sent a letter to the Meyers that asked for 5 items to be satisfied in order to get the 2 properties in line with WPCA regulations.

1. Assume the full ownership of the lateral sewers, 2. Repair the existing manhole (on the property) 3. Seek an exception to WPCA regulation 3.4 (since there is two laterals in a private manhole that leads to a single lateral), 4. Pay an assessment of \$6,934.00 and 5. Show proof of water supply by Aquarion water to the WPCA Board.

Discussion ensued between Atty. Stanek and the board about the past history of the property and how the assessment could be paid. Atty. Stanek did remonstrate with the board, that the property had only one assessment on it at the time of the closing (August 9th, 2000) per title search and as such were unaware. The board recommended that the homcowners and Atty. Stanek discuss options with Atty. Bruchal. **Jon Livolsi** made a

motion, Stephen Chucta 2nd, to table this until next meeting (February 3rd, 200). Motion passed 4-0.

Veolia water report—Jon Marro submitted this to the board. Of note, a DEP required water sampler was purchased, the thickener was repaired, and the board made note of consistent reports of rags and grease in Titus pump station. Jim Galligan was asked to look into the Oxford influx into this pump station.

Income report- Jon Marro submitted this to the board.

Finance report- this was submitted to the board.
