TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS AND PERSONS:

The purpose of this notice is to notify the public that the Naugatuck Valley Health District is proposing to use federal funds under the HUD Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program within a FEMA designated 100-year floodplain. The proposed program would involve lead hazard control/reduction activities and minor rehabilitation on residential properties within the municipalities of Ansonia, Beacon Falls, Derby, Naugatuck, Seymour and Shelton. The target areas contain floodplains and project sites could be located within Flood Zones A, AO, AE, AH, A1-A30 and A99, as designated by the Flood Insurance Rate Maps.

PROJECT: Naugatuck Valley Emends Lead Hazards (NauVEL) Project #CTLHB0387-08 for contract period Jan. 11, 2009 to Dec. 31, 2011.

PURPOSE: NauVEL will provide lead-based paint hazard reduction through interim controls or hazard abatement to make 154 existing residential units lead-safe using federal funds.

LOCATION: See target area description above.

All affected and interested agencies, groups and persons are encouraged to participate in this decision-making process for the proposed action in the floodplain.
