Thank you to the anonymous donor who built the new permanent bathrooms at the Seymour High School upper field. The bathrooms were completed just in time for our first home game against Oxford. We are in the process of ordering new LED lights for our Football Field. This will be not only a cost savings on electricity but also reduce our light pollution when the lights are on.

Our next steps are to go out for a RFQ (Request for Qualifications) for the design work for new pool and gymnasium. The pool is the original pool from 1969 and the gymnasium is too small. A new gymnasium and the pool would benefit both the town and community.

The Town is also in the processes of looking at the cost to move the baseball field from French Park to the High School. By moving the baseball team back to the High School, it would eliminate the need for bussing the teams to and from French Park, the teams would not have to leave school early to catch the bus for practice, parents who have children playing two sports would not have to leave to travel across town and sit in traffic, and the best part of this is that we will have all our teams on our school campus.
