Instructions

- Applications <u>must</u> be submitted to the Office of the Building Inspector.
- Applicants are responsible for scheduling inspections with Town Engineer (203) 881-8145.
 Applicant must contact Seymour
 Police to coordinate traffic control
- The issued permit shall be a copy of this application signed by the Director of Public Works or Town Engineer
- · Certificate of insurance, copy of license and certificate of bond (\$10,000) must be provided with completed application.

Conditions of Permit

Permit fee:

- 1) The Town Engineer <u>must</u> be notified <u>48 hours</u> in advance of the start of any work authorized under this permit, (203) 881-8145.
- 2) Work authorized under this permit shall <u>not</u> commence <u>until</u> the second day following the date of issue.
- 3) This permit is valid for ninety (90) days after its date of issue.
- 4) Compaction equipment is <u>required</u> to be on site at <u>all times</u> and shall be utilized during all backfilling operations.
- 5) The permittee shall <u>notify</u> the Town Engineer's office when the trench will be ready to backfill, and wait for the inspector to arrive before backfilling any opening in a right-of-way. Any backfill placed in the absence of the inspector shall be removed and replaced to the satisfaction of the inspector.
- 6) The <u>permittee</u> is <u>responsible</u> for maintaining the temporary pavement until all settlement has ceased and the permanent pavement has been installed. The Town will notify the permittee of the installation of the permanent pavement.
- 7) The <u>permittee</u> is <u>responsible</u> for maintaining adequate traffic control devices throughout the excavation period.
