CURBSIDE RECYCLING & REFUSE GUIDE

Please keep and refer to this guide to assist with the transition to the Town of Seymour's curbside collection program. Oak Ridge is proud to partner with the town to attempt to increase the towns recycling rates and make it easier for you, the residents, to dispose of your recyclables and garbage.

In the enclosed flyer you will see your streets and the days of service that correspond to your home. Recycling pick up will now be every week instead of bi-weekly, and it will fall on the same day as your garbage pick up day. Please consult the last page for items that are considered "Acceptable Recyclables" or refer to our website, www.oakridgewaste.com for additional information.

As soon as you have your carts, you can start using them. Enclosed are directions on how to set them out on the curb. Please attempt to keep them accessible by the truck and not blocked by vehicles, snow piles, or anything that would prohibit our drivers from efficiently accessing the containers with the truck.

Dear Resident,

The Town of Seymour recently reached an agreement with Oak Ridge Waste & Recycling, the company has provided Seymour's recycling service. As a result of this agreement, residents will receive expanded and improved garbage and recycling services at the potential cost savings to the taxpayer, but we need your help!

As part of the agreement, residents who currently receive public waste disposal services will receive 2 sturdy, 96-gallon tote receptacles, one for recycling and one for garbage pickup, at no cost. If you think you will need more than two receptacles, extra bins can be purchased for approximately \$150 each. These are special receptacles designed to work with Oak Ridge's automated disposal system. Residents should experience less damage to these receptacles, which will be gently placed on the ground by the new trucks' automated arms and are less likely to be blown around by strong winds. Should any damage be encountered, however, the Department of Public Works can arrange a replacement.

Additionally, residents will now receive weekly garbage and recycling pick up, rather than every other week recycling. Some residents may receive a pick up on a different day of the week than they currently do, but both services will be delivered on the same day, which should limit confusion.

Best of all, the improvements can save you, the taxpayer, money if you do your part! Due to newly negotiated reimbursement rates for recycling, if we, as a town contribute just 2 more tons of recycling per year, or approximately 25 pounds more per household, the Town will save money compared to our current contract. As such, we're taking the opportunity to remind everyone how important recycling is in Seymour. Seymour utilizes what is known as "single stream" recycling, which means metals, plastics, glass, and paper don't need to be separated in your recycling bins. Further, Seymour residents can recycle all plastics from #1 - #7. For more information about what can be recycled, see the infographic included in this informational packet.

As with everything else, this transition will not be without its issues. We ask for your patience and participation to help make this process as simple and successful as possible. If everyone does their part, we have a rare opportunity to improve municipal services and save the taxpayer money at the same time. Please see the following important information regarding placement of your containers:

GARBAGE

RECYCLING



TRASH CART

- No hazardous waste
- No fluorescent bulbs/tubes
- No flammable items
- No ashes
- No oversize or heavy items (dirt, rock, concrete, sod)
- No recyclable items

RECYCLING CART

See last page for items to recycle

CART PLACEMENT

- Place by road, not blocked by obstacles (cars)
- Leave space between the carts
- Free from overhead obstacles
- Items must fall freely from the cart

FILLING THE CART

A. Everything must fit completely inside of the cart. Contents must be level and lid **MUST BE CLOSED**.

B. **Trash** must be bagged & must fall freely from the cart.

C. Place heavier items toward the bottom for emptying ease.

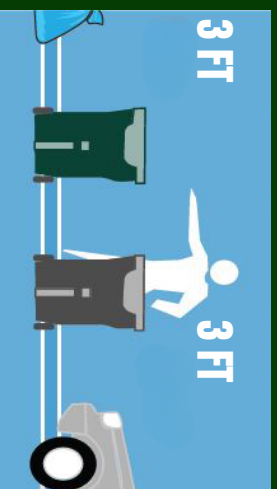
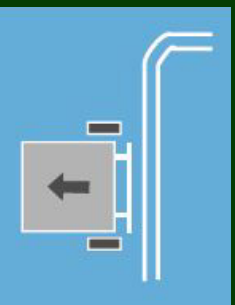
Park it

Cart should be on the street with the wheels against the curb.



Point it

Arrows should point to the center of the road.



Space it

Give at least an arm's length of clearance on all sides.

Place your trash and recycling cans at the curb with the wheels facing your house and the lid opening into the street.

Keep your garbage cans 3 feet apart and at least 3 feet or more from any obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, lamp posts, or power lines.

Keep your container at the curb until the end of the day if it hasn't been collected. Sometimes the timing of our arrival changes, and we don't want to miss you if we come later than expected.

It's generally best to put your container out the night before your collection day. That way even if we are early, you won't miss your pick up.

Here are some simple pointers on what to recycle and how!

Paper & Cardboard

YES

Newspapers, Magazines & Catalogs
White or colored paper
Smooth cardboard
Paper bags
Flattened cardboard
Shredded paper

NO

Plastic or wax coated paper
Carbon paper
Heavily soiled paper or cardboard
Hardcover books



Metal, Glass & Plastic

YES

Metal cans
Foil wrap & trays
Plastic bottles & jugs
Glass bottles & jars
Beverage cartons
Household metals
Plastic trays or tubs
Plastic toys

NO

Motor oil or chemical containers
Styrofoam
Plastic bags, wrap or film
Plastic utensils, plates, cups, bowls
Lightbulbs
Caps or lids
Pane glass
Household batteries
