IMPROVEMENTS UNDERWAY

Work continues to progress along Botsford and Bungay Road. The contractor has completed tree removals to make way for upcoming sidewalk and retaining wall installations. In addition, new catch basin tops and drainage pipes have been installed along Botsford Rd. These upgrades will improve drainage in the area, helping to protect the road's overall integrity and ensure its long-term durability.

Better drainage will also reduce standing water and ice patches during the colder months, improving safety for drivers and pedestrians alike.

New utility poles have also been installed. Wire transfers to the new poles will begin soon.



UP NEXT

This week, crews started grinding down the old road surface on Botsford Road and making any needed repairs.

Work has also begun to prepare the area for a new retaining wall along Bungay Rd.

During the week of April 21, workers will begin paving the first layer of asphalt and installing curbs along Botsford Road. Crews will also start replacing storm drain covers on Bungay.

Expect one lane of traffic at a time through the Bungay Rd work zone, with police officers helping to direct cars safely.
