# November Election / Who - When - and Where's

## Who can vote in the November Election?

US Citizens who are registered can participate in voting. *Note: Former Seymour residents who are US Citizens should contact the Town Clerk's office to determine eligibility* 

#### **Important Registration Dates:**

**October 17, 2025:** Last day to register in person and mail-in. The Registrar of Voters will be open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. for in person registration. All mail-in voter registration applications must be received or post-marked by this date in order to be accepted. The Online Voter Registration System will also close on this date at 11:59 p.m.

**Voter Registration for Early Voting:** Same Day Registration (SDR) is available at the Early Voting location during the early voting period (October 20th-November 2nd)

**November 3, 2025:** Deadline for admitting those seeking to vote in the Election whose qualification as to age, citizenship, or residence was attained on or after October 17<sup>th</sup>. Registrar of Voter's office will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

November 4, 2025: Same Day Registration/Voting available at Town Hall 6 a.m.-8 p.m.
