SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL



Together, we are responsible for keeping the Town of Seymour safe for winter walking. For your own safety and to help your neighbors, including people pushing strollers, using wheelchairs, exercising, and the many children and adults who walk throughout Seymour, please do your part.

REMOVAL OF SNOW & ICE

Property owners must clear sidewalks on all sides of their property for pedestrian travel.

All ice must be removed from sidewalks. Once cleared, light sanding is encouraged to reduce slipping hazards.

Snow must be piled on private property. Depositing snow into the street is prohibited and may result in a citation from the Police Department.

AVOID A FINE

Failure to clear sidewalks after a storm may result in enforcement action. If the Town of Seymour receives a complaint, the property owner may be subject to a \$100 fine.

OWNER RESPONSIBILITY

Property owners are responsible for removing both snow and ice from sidewalks. Ice presents a significant safety hazard and may be more dangerous than snow.

- Timely and complete snow removal reduces the likelihood of ice formation.
- Property owners must ensure sidewalk maintenance continues while they are on vacation.
